

SUBJECT DATE CODE FOR CLAUDE (FRANCE) FLUORESCENT LAMPS

The following date code applies to lamps branded with the stamp shown on specification SM-CL-002 and SM-CL-003

The date code is made up of an upper and lower row of dots, which are for the month and year respectively and a dash over the letter W (for watts) which indicates the first half of the year.

The arrangement is as follows:-

Upper row of dots:-

6 dots	January or July
5 dots	February or August
4 dots	March or September
3 dots	April or October
2 dots	May or November
1 dot	June or December

Lower row of dots:-

5 dots	1971
4 dots	1972
3 dots	1973
2 dots	1974
1 dot	1975

First half of any year with the dash over the letter W.

Second half of any year without the dash over the letter W.
